Riley was diagnosed with Down syndrome shortly after her birth. We had many questions and concerns about how our baby would develop and learn. She stayed with a sitter until

she was nine-months-old. When it came time to put her in daycare, we were excited and nervous. We had been on several day care waiting lists. As we tried to get Riley enrolled in a school we got the same response, "We're sorry, but we don't accept children with disabilities." Frustrated and in tears, we did not know what to do. Riley was "normal" to us but she would not be accepted in any day care center.

My mother had heard about Goldman School & Child Development Center and made the phone call that changed our lives. Not only did the school have an opening for Riley, but her differences would be celebrated not looked down upon.

In June of 2006 at nine months old, Riley was enrolled at Goldman School. She was in the capable hands of well trained teachers and because of the school's inclusion model, she was able to learn from her typically developing peers. Within two weeks Riley was holding her own bottle.

Riley is now five-years-old. She has learned to walk, feed herself and is talking up a storm. She receives speech therapy at the school and her teachers work with her to surpass each milestone. Riley enjoys art, music, story time, and outside play

Riley's progress has been so wonderful, and we have been so pleased. We cannot say enough good things about our Goldman family. We feel blessed every day that we have been so fortunate to find such a wonderful place for our little girl.
